DESCRIPTION

A high alkaline cleaner and degreaser. Can be used on natural stone, grout, ceramic, porcelain, terra cotta, quarry tiles, concrete, pavers and masonry.

USES

- Oil, grease and food stains
- Sap and certain stains from plants
- General dirt and grime
- Light cement contamination on acid sensitive surfaces

TEST FIRST

Due to the nature of different surfaces, you should do several test areas in inconspicuous areas according to the label instructions to determine surface colour stability and desired results. The end user must determine the suitability of the product for their intended use.

PRECAUTIONS

- For external use only. Causes burns. DO NOT mix with other products.
- Keep children and animals away from the product and treated surfaces until rinsed off.
- Wear suitable clothing (gloves, eye protection and footwear) to prevent skin and eye contamination.
- If splashed in eyes rinse continuously with water. Remove contact lenses if possible. Seek medical attention or a poison center.
- Keep of all other surfaces, clothing and plants.
- Always test on a small, inconspicuous area first. This will allow you to establish how severe the soiling is and the best application method.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Sweep, vacuum or wipe the surface first.
- 2. Pre-wet the surface with clean water.
- 3. Dilute PowerClean as follows: LIGHT contamination: 1 part PowerClean to 10 parts water. MODERATE contamination: 1 part PowerClean to 5 parts water. HEAVY contamination: 1 part PowerClean to 3 parts water.
- 4. Apply to the pre-wetted surface with a sponge or mop.
- 5. Work in small areas.
- ${\bf 6.}\ A git at e \ with \ a \ long \ handled \ scrubbing \ brush \ or \ nylon \ pad.$
- 7. Apply clean water and agitate with a brush.
- 8. Allow minimum dwell time of 5-10 minutes.
- 9. DO NOT ALLOW PRODUCT TO DRY ON THE SURFACE.
- 10. Remove dirty solution with a mop or wet vacuum cleaner.
- 11. Apply more clean water and agitate with a brush.
- 12. Remove with a mop or wet vacuum cleaner.
- 13. Repeat rinsing process as required.

LIMITATIONS

- Do not allow product to come in contact with any nonrecommended surfaces.
- Regular use of high alkaline cleaners will affect the performance of sealers.

HANDLING AND STORAGE

- Keep container tightly closed when not in use.
- Store in original container only.
- Store in temperatures between 4°C and 32°C.
- Wash hands with soap and water after handling.
- Keep out of reach of children and animals.

SPILLAGES

Spills of up to 1 litre can be rinsed away to waste water drains with large quantities of water. Spills of over 1 litre should be contained and absorbed onto sand, sawdust or other suitable material. Residues should be collected and disposed of as hazardous chemical waste in suitably labelled containers.

FIRST AID

INHALATION – Remove from exposure. If breathing becomes difficult seek seek medical attention.

EYE CONTACT - hold eyelids apart and flush the eye continuously with running water. Continue flushing until advised to stop by a medical professional or a Doctor, or for at least 15 minutes. Remove contact lenses if possible.

SKIN CONTACT - remove contaminated clothing and flush skin

and hair with running water. If irritation persists, seek medical attention.

INGESTATION - rinse mouth with water and give a glass of water (500 ml) to drink. Do NOT induce vomiting. Seek immediate medical attention.
